All artists/vendors and helpers will be stamped at check-in. For in an out privileges during the event, you must present your stamp to the door person with your lanyard. You will not be re-admitted without your stamp. Stamps will be administered every morning of the event.

Oregon Ink Staff will be available at check-in to assist with move-in, assisting in booth location, and answering any questions you may have.

Move-in and move-out will be through the loading docks on the east side of the Event Center. All booths need to be set up no later than noon Friday for OHLA inspection, ready for the 2PM start.

Upon check-in, you will receive:

- Labeled Venue Map.
- Official Artist/Vendor lanyards.
- Event Schedules

Temporary Licenses not obtained prior to check-in will be available Friday morning from OHLA.

Booth Set-up:

Each booth is 10 ft x 10 ft with Pipe and Drape backdrops. Each booth comes with:

- Two 8 ft rectangle tables with table clothes and 2 chairs.
- Trash can
- Sharps Container

All other amenities and supplies, such as heavy-duty power strips,

etc., are the responsibility of the vendors.

Hot and cold water will be available in designated areas of the venue.

Parking: We kindly ask that all exhibitors park in the East parking lot behind the Events Center. This is the area where you'll be moving in.

Expo Center Rules and Regulations:

- State law prohibits smoking inside any of our buildings.
- No animals will be allowed in the buildings, either on or off a leash, except as an aid to a disabled person. Animals outside facility buildings must be on a leash and the owner is responsible for picking up after their pets.
- The parking lot is a common area for all events, and event usage will have priority. The main lot is for individuals attending scheduled events. Parking of utility/storage vehicles will not be permitted in the main parking lot.
- The Lane Events Center is the exclusive provider of all food and beverage on the grounds.

No outside food or beverage is allowed period.

Tattoo Contests

There is a \$5.00 fee to enter each contest.

1st and 2nd place will be awarded for each contest. Contestants can sign up the day of the contest at the Oregon Ink Information Booth located next to the stage.

Tattoo Contest Rules

- All contests will be judged by at least three judges.
- All Best of Day entries must be started and completed at the convention.
- Sign-ups for each contest will close 20 minutes before each contest.

For all categories, (other than Best of Day) the tattoo must be completely healed. To be determined at time of sign-up.

Art Gallery:

There will be an art gallery accessible from the main lobby. All art will be professionally hung Thursday May 6th and Friday morning May 7th. Due to limited space, there will be a cut-off if the submissions exceed the space available. Interested parties need to contact us and let us know the size and medium of the piece being submitted. All art can be placed "on sale" or for "display only." Please contact Teresita for more information.

Best Shop Assistant:

There will be on-going contests Friday and Saturday for the best shop assistant. Some contests are quite embarrassing, while others are not. Contestants can sign up Friday by 4 PM at the Oregon Ink Information Booth located next to the stage. Only one representative per shop, please.

Misc.

If you need a phone line for your booth, there is a \$125 charge for phone line installation.

RV parking is available. If interested, please contact the Lane Events Center for hook up

Artist Supplement

Artists must either use disposable equipment or bring enough equipment for the weekend. If artists choose to use their own equipment, they're responsible for bringing their latest spore test results.

All Oregon body artists are responsible for bringing their individual practitioner's license (EPT) to the event and have them posted or readily available upon request. Out of state artists must have their temporary license on site. (See attached application for details)

Sharps containers will be provided at check in; Artists/Shops are responsible for proper disposal.

Oregon Ink staff will come by periodically to assist in the disposal of trash. Trash bags and assistance with pick up are available upon request. Trash cans will be provided.

Although electricity is available in each booth, don't forget to bring electrical cords and surge protectors (Heavy Duty).

Thermofax and copiers will be available at two locations in the venue. Thermofax paper will be available for a nominal fee.

Radios are allowed, but loud music will not be tolerated. Please play your music at a reasonable volume. Violators will be warned once, then ejected on 2nd violation.

Although artists and vendors are encouraged to decorate their space as they please, any banner or decoration that is to be hung from the pipe must be fire retardant. Keep

the weight of such booth decorations at a minimum.

There will be a \$100 licensing fee for any shops wanting to pierce at the event. Let us know that this is your intention, and register the piercing practitioner license on the registration form. (See OHLA contact information below for more information)

Unless otherwise approved by the promoters (Oregon Ink), there is to be no solicitation or cross-promotion of any kind allowed, as well as announcements of other events or shows, handing-out bills, fliers, postcards, or business cards (other than participating shops and vendors' promotional materials) anywhere inside the show, outside the exhibit hall, in the parking lot, or anywhere within the convention facility without prior consent of the Oregon Ink promoters. Violators will be escorted out by security guards or police officers without refund and may be cited for trespassing.

No commercial photography allowed without prior permission from the Oregon Ink promoters and/or Ink Junkie Magazine.

Licensing and Identification

All body arts practiced at the Oregon Ink must be performed by artists registered to practice at the convention. A minimum age requirement of 18 years old will be enforced for all tattooing and body piercing. Proof of I.D. is required, and must be copied and kept on file on-site with all consent forms.

The State of Oregon requires all persons being tattooed be a minimum of 18 years of age regardless of parental consent.

Client/Practitioner Health related Information

- Aftercare instructions will be available at the copy area. If you prefer, you may bring your own. Please make sure the client receives these instructions and understands them. No client should receive body art if they are judged to be intoxicated. This responsibility is on the artist to determine.
- Body Piercing of genitals or nipples must be screened from public viewing. If you plan to offer this service, your station must include an opaque screen for such purposes. You are obligated to bring this yourself; it is not included with your booth registration. All materials used to create your piercing station must be fire retardant. Please keep in mind that the Fire Marshall will be inspecting.

Oregon Health and Licensing Agency

The State of Oregon has its own set of rules regarding Body Art Practices. If you have not already done so, please obtain, read, and understand the regulations set forth by the Oregon Health and Licensing Agency. (www.oregon.gov/ohla)
